

- For Dance Events Mixed Participation (Girls & Boys) is not allowed.
- Strictly follow rules and regulations of FISAT ARANGU 2025.
- Decision taken by Judging committee would be deemed final.
- Arangu Organizing committee has right to change any event time and venue.
- Any appeal must be reported within 30minutes to appeal committee.
- For each event, students are not allowed to be part of multiple teams.
- Events that do not have a minimum of 3 Registrations will be cancelled.
- Any decisions taken by judges will be deemed final.







1. Group Dance (M)

- Time Duration: 7minutes (including settings)
- Members in a team- Min: 3 & Max: 12 at a time on stage (total limited to 15)
- No Swapping.(Chest No- Lot system)

2. Group Dance (F)

- Time Duration: 7minutes (including settings)
- Members in a team Min: 3 & Max: 10 at a time on stage (total limited to 15)
- No Swapping.(Chest No- Lot system)

3. Split screen

- A group of two people can participate(either two boys or two girls, or a boy and a girl).
- Separate team for Male & Female
- Time Duration: 7minutes (including settings)
- No. of Participants: 2

4. Bharatanatyam, Mohiniyattam, Kuchipudi

- No of Participants: 1
- 3 accompanist are allowed if required.
- Duration: 15 minutes.
- For various dance items non-students shall be allowed to provide background music (both vocal & Instrumental).

5. Spot Choreo

- Time allotted: Maximum 5min.
- Songs will be provided on the spot.
- Performance and costume should be in a decent manner.

6. Instrumental band with Vocal

- Max members: 10
- Playing time: 20mnts, setting: 10mnts,







7. Light Music: (M & F)

- Time Duration: 5 minutes.
- Only non film folk songs can be presented.
- Instruments are not allowed.
- Judgement is made on the qualities like swaram, thai, composition, general impression.

8. Western Vocals Solo

- Time Duration: 5 minutes.
- Time for Stage/instruments setting: 5 min
- The number of accompanists should not be more than two.
- Language of the song: English only.

9. Recitation- Malayalam

• Time duration: 5 minutes

10. Mono Act

- Time Duration: 5 minutes
- Judgment will be based on the ability to act, clarity of language, literary expression originality, humour general impression, etc.

11. Mimicry

- Time Duration: 5 minutes.
- No of Participant: 1
- Judgement will be based on command of voice imitative ability, originality, humour, general impression etc.







11. Voice of Arangu

- A group of two people can participate(either two boys or two girls, or a boy and a girl).
- The duration of the song must be between 5 and 8 minutes. The time limit should be strictly followed.
- Only filmy or folk Indian language songs can be presented.
- Participants can bring karaoke tracks with them or be accompanied by a member on any instrument(preferably a guitar or keyboard.)

12. Stand-up Comedy

- It is an individual competition.
- The time limit is 4-5 minutes
- Participants will be judged based on the content, fluency, spontaneity, presentation, and sense of humor
- No participant can point out any particular religion in any way, and any dual meaning absence content is strictly not allowed.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.

13. Mappila Pattu

- Time Duration: 5 minutes.
- Only traditional or contemporary Mappilapattu songs allowed
- Instruments are not allowed.







14. String Western (Guitar, Keyboard)

- Maximum 7 minutes per performance, including setup.
- Participants must bring their own guitar or keyboard. No instruments will be provided.
- Only Western music pieces are allowed (no classical or fusion).

15. Kolkkali

- No. of Team Members : 6 to 10 members.
- Maximum 7 minutes is allowed, including setup.
- Judging Criteria based on Synchronization, rhythm, formations, and traditional authenticity.

16. Oppana

- No. of Team Members : 8 to 12 members (including the bride).
- Maximum 7 minutes, including entry and exit.
- Only traditional Oppana songs are allowed.
- Traditional Oppana attire is mandatory.

17. Thiruvathira

- No. of Team Members : 6 to 10 members.
- Maximum 7 minutes is allowed, including setup.
- Only traditional Thiruvathira songs are permitted.
- Participants must wear traditional Thiruvathira Attires







18. Margamkali

- No. of Team Members : 6 to 12 members.
- Maximum 7 minutes is allowed, including setup.
- Only traditional Margamkali choreography is allowed.
- Participants must wear traditional Margamkali dress.

20. Theme Show

- Each team should consist of a specified number of participants in min of 6 max of 12
- The theme is open theme ie Participants can choose any topic for their presentation or performance.
- Creativity in presenting the theme is encouraged while maintaining relevance.
- The performance should be within the given time limit(7 mints); exceeding the time may lead to penalties.
- Proper coordination among team members is essential for a smooth presentation.
- Costumes and props should align with the theme and be appropriate for the event.
- Participants must ensure that their act is suitable for all audiences and does not contain offensive content.
- Any form of misconduct , misbehavior display of vulgarity may result in disqualification.
- The event schedule must be followed, and last-minute changes will not be accommodated.
- The judging panel will evaluate performances based on creativity, adherence to the theme, execution, and overall impact.







21. DJ HUNT

- Each DJ will have 5-7 minutes to perform, including setup.
- Participants must bring their own DJ controllers/laptops.
- Basic sound systems and mixers will be provided.
- Use of explicit or offensive content is strictly prohibited.
- Any form of misconduct or rule violation will lead to disqualification.







ARANGU '25 - OFFSTAGE EVENTS

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Poetry writing (English & Malayalam), Essay writing (English, Malayalam), Story writing (Malayalam, English)
 - Time duration : 1 hour 30 minutes
 - The language of the competition should be strictly used.
 - No reference material will be permitted
 - The content shall be original and not borrowed and copied from others.
 - The topic will be given on the spot.

2. Poster Designing

- Theme will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition
- Time Duration : 2 hours 30 minutes
- Net facility/ External devices should not be used

3. Pencil Drawing

- Theme will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition
- Paper required will be supplied.
- Participants should bring Pencil & Eraser.
- Time Duration:1 hour.
- No of Participants : 1







4. Photography Competition

- No. of Participant: 1
- Time duration: 3 hours.
- Participants are required to bring their own digital cameras or mobile phones
- Participants can submit photographs of Min-2 & Max-5
- Participants are also required to bring their own usb cable, card reader etc..
- Photographs should not include any kind of vulgarity or offensive matter. Any such activity might cause the disqualification of the participant and recommend for disciplinary action.
- No mixing, matching or morphing of photographs will be permitted. Software such as Photoshop etc. for enhancing images not permitted (ie. Original photographs should be submitted)
- Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (i) Impact, (ii) Composition, (iii) Technical quality, (iv) suitability of the specific theme.
- The additional instructions will be announced on the spot by an expert.
- The subject will be given on the spot.

5. Wall Painting

- Time duration: Max 10 hours.
- Participants: mini-2 &Max-4
- Space for wall painting would be provided.
- Painting should not include any kind of vulgarity or offensive matter. Any such activity might cause the disqualification of the participant and recommend for disciplinary action.
- Prior permission must be obtained for the drawing
- Participants should bring their own articles required.







6. Reels Competition

- Participants can compete individually or in teams (max 3 members).
- The reel must align with the given theme (Theme will be announced during registration).
- Content must be original, creative, and engaging.
- Use of offensive, explicit, or plagiarized content will lead to disqualification.
- Reels must be submitted before the deadline (late entries will not be accepted).
- Participants must upload their reels to Google Drive and share the link or submit via the provided platform.
